Nanci Patten Sweazey - Athlete Category

One of the traits that's valued among Masters athletes is versatility. Nanci Patten Sweazey is mostly known for her Race Walking. But before that, she competed in figure skating, volleyball, gymnastics, badminton, diving AND MORE! In Masters Race Walking, Nanci has held many Canadian records, and still presently holds several, from 1500 to 5000 metres, both indoors and out, and outdoors also in 10K and 20K. These records span from 1995 to 2006. She has achieved medals at Worlds becoming OMA Female Athlete of the Year twice. She has also medalled in steeplechase, cross-country, and road races. Versatility is her middle name! We are pleased to add Nanci Patten Sweazey to our OMA Hall of Fame, 2013.

Nanci Patten Sweazey in Her Own Words
I started as a figure skater at age 5 until I was 19;
2 things that got me into track - in public school there was
"sports day" and I discovered running and long jump!
In high school I was on the cross country team, track team, basketball, volleyball, gymnastics, trampoline club, and a cheerleader - won my athletic letter.

1970 - 79 competed in doubles badminton, 5m diving, trampoline in winter then sailed and canoed in the summers! My father took me to the Star indoor games (I think in 1972) where I saw Grant McLaren running and I was inspired for middle distance.

University of Toronto - volleyball team, cross country runner and Ice hockey team - won my athletic letter.

I met my husband Robin Sweazey, and his brother was a racewalker and I was injured, so I ran beside him - until I tried walking. I watched as 55 yr old Alex Oakley just missed making the Commonwealth team and was so inspired by him, Marcel Jobin, Pierre LaPointe and Guilluam LaBlanc and Glen Sweazey, and some of the other great race-walkers at that time - so 6 months later I raced in Edmonton Canadian Championships indoors and set a new Canadian record in the 1,500m winning against current Canadian champion Ann Peel.

In 1980 I raced on my first World Cup team (New York) and the second in Bergen Norway (3 months pregnant) - too bad there was not an Olympic event for women at that time!
