

Stan Egerton

Stan Egerton has had a varied and interesting career in athletics, beginning as a sprinter. In 1950, in New Zealand, at the British Empire Games, he won the silver for the Pole Vault. His Masters career began in 1975, at age 50, and lasted 35 years, with many medals won in Pole Vault, Sprints (60 to 400 metres), as well as Long Jump, Triple Jump and High Jump at Ontario, Canadian and world meets. Along with the wins came many Canadian records and a world record in M60 in 1986 in 60 metres. Several age group records in Pole Vault are still standing. He has also been instrumental in guiding younger vaulters, who found him to be very generous with time and advice.

The board of directors and members of Ontario Masters Athletics welcome Stan Egerton into the Hall of Fame in 2011.
