

Paul Osland

Paul is an extremely accomplished, athlete, coach and administrator in Masters athletics. Here are just a few of his achievements:

- Fifteen World Masters medals
- Canadian Record Holder for the M50 Indoor 800 and Indoor 1500
- Over the past five years, he maintained an age grading over 94% for the 800, and 92% for the 1500. Those are world class numbers.
- He is the current and long-time Canadian Masters President, and is a former Ontario Masters Director
- He is a key member of the Bid Committee and Local Organizing Committee for Toronto's successful bid to host the World Masters Outdoor Championships in 2020
- He co-founded one of Canada's largest masters training groups, at the University of Toronto. Twenty of those athletes competed at Worlds in Malaga this month.
- He coaches dozens of masters athletes, including multiple-time World Masters medalists Mike Sherar and Annie Bunting
